### Guide to Mitigating Water Usage

Everybody should look for ways to reduce their water usage both in their personal and their professional lives. This will help to guarantee a sustainable supply of clean, safe water in the future.



#### How can a business become more water efficient?

- **Monitor Water Consumption**

Using a smart meter is the best way to monitor your water usage. Knowing how much you use and where can help you to identify areas of potential savings. Monitor bills closely on an ongoing basis to identify changes to patterns of water consumption.

- **Do a Water Maintenance Check**

Old or unmaintained equipment can mean increased water usage. Work with facilities maintenance specialists to determine a reasonable preventative maintenance schedule.

- **Don't Run Appliances on Half Loads**

If you have a dishwasher, washing machine or similar appliance within your building, you should only run this on a full load.

- **Install Water Saving Measures**

Use a water butt to collect rainwater off your roof. Water butts usually hold around 200litres of water which can be used for watering plants or cleaning vehicles.



- **Engage and Inform Employees**

Offer training to all employees as well as put guides and posters around the building to inform them on what needs to happen water-wise within the business to meet your water-saving goals and explain why it is so important to follow the new guidance.
